

## PUBLIX PARTNERS PARTICIPATION TERMS

- Schools must be an accredited public or private school providing academic education for any combination of grades kindergarten through 12th grade in order to be eligible to participate in (and to continue participation in) the Publix Partners Program (“Program”). Publix reserves the right to determine whether a particular entity is an eligible school. Program is only available for schools located in Georgia, South Carolina, North Carolina, Alabama, Tennessee and Virginia.
- Publix will make quarterly contributions to a school based on the accumulated eligible sales that are made at specifically designated Publix stores during the applicable fiscal quarter by customers who have selected to support that school under the Program. For every \$37,500.00 in eligible purchases, the school will earn \$250.00. Schools must earn \$250.00 in order to receive a check from Publix, any amount less than \$250.00 will be carried over to the next quarter.
- In order for schools to earn money, customers must register for a Publix.com account, sign up for the Program and then select the school that they want to support. Each time the customer shops at an eligible store, they can help earn money for their chosen school by entering their phone number in the PIN Pad during check-out. All purchases are eligible with the exception of: (i) gift cards, alcohol, lottery items, money services, postage stamps and prescriptions; (ii) purchases from Florida stores; and (iii) purchases from GreenWise Market locations; (iv) purchases made through Publix Delivery powered by Instacart and Publix Curbside powered by Instacart.
- Publix will provide the school with a quarterly statement on or before the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the month following the end of each fiscal quarter of Publix. If the school has met the minimum earning requirement, Publix will send a check payable to the school with the quarterly statement. The amount shown as being credited or paid on the statement shall be considered the correct amount unless a written objection is received by Publix from the school within thirty (30) days after the date of the statement.
- At any time, Publix may, at its sole discretion, decide to continue the Program, modify the Program and/or these terms, or discontinue the Program. By continuing to participate in the Program following such modifications schools agree to be bound by such modifications. We will post our most current Publix Partners Participation Terms on [publix.com/partners](https://publix.com/partners), and schools should periodically visit this page to review them. If a school wants to discontinue their participation in the Program, the school shall notify Publix of its request in writing. The school will forfeit all contributions that have not met the minimum earning requirement at the time that the school discontinues participation.
